Nick Joyce will be giving a brief illustrated talk on the history and architectural significance of York Place, Worcester

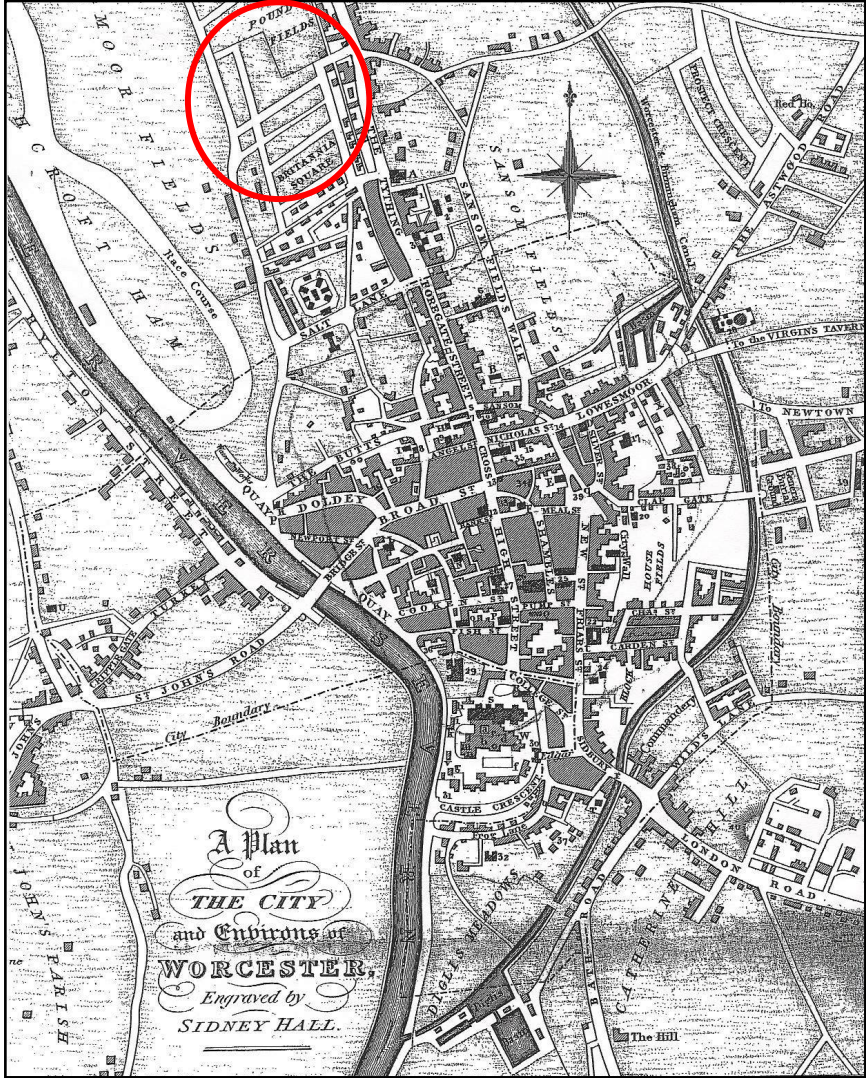

The talk will follow on from the Residents' Association Meeting which is to be held at 7:30pm at the United Reformed Church Hall, Albany Terrace.

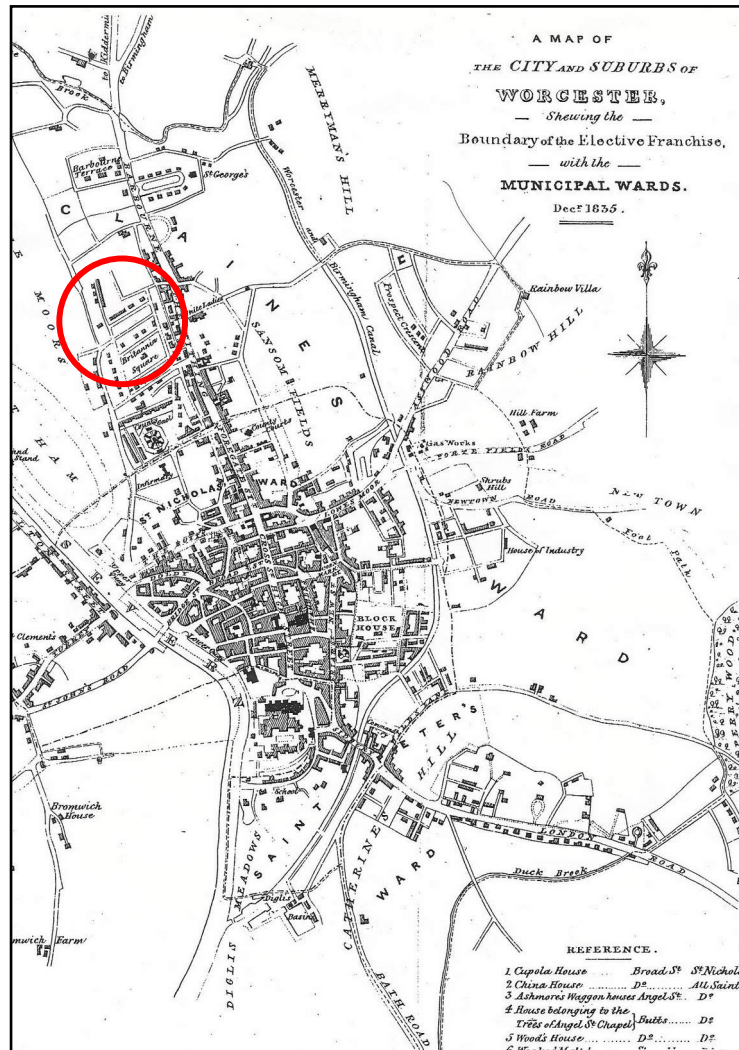

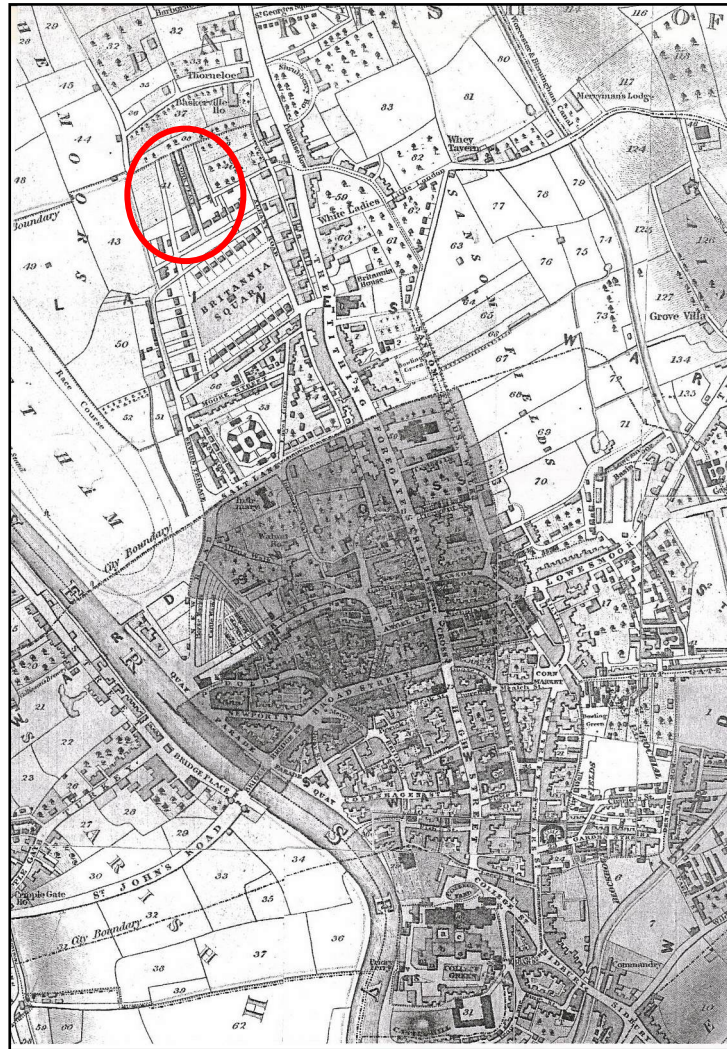

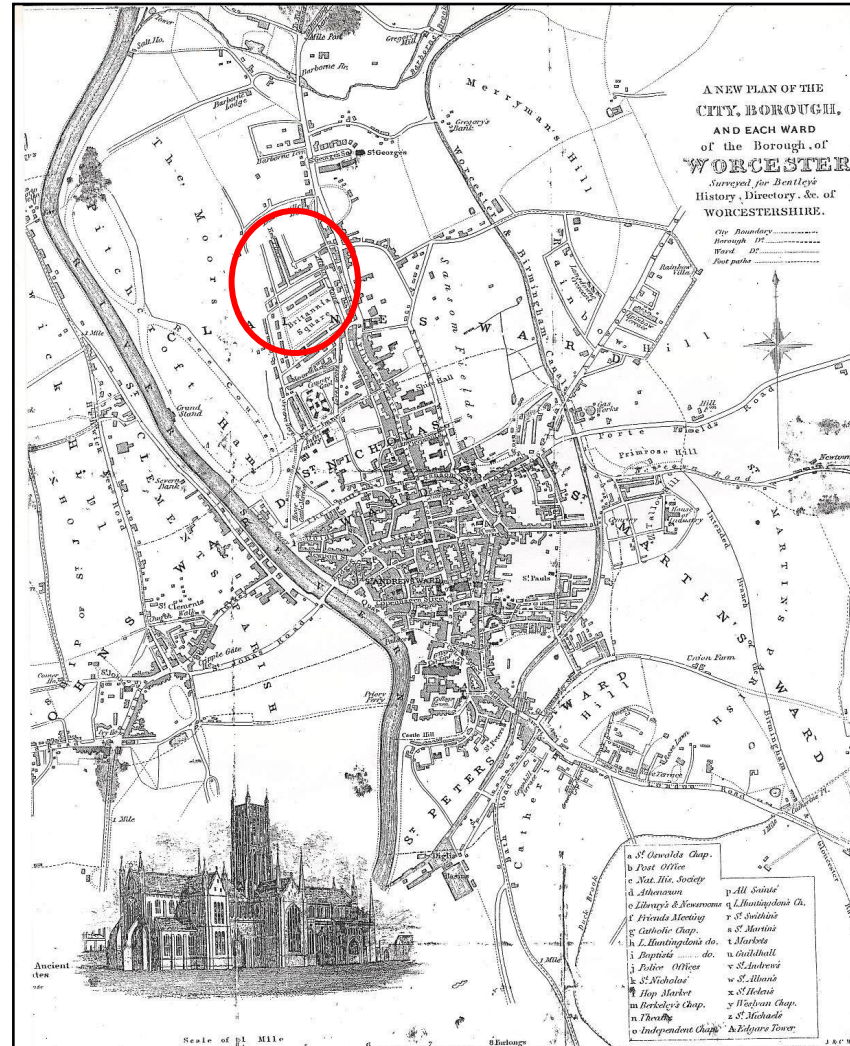

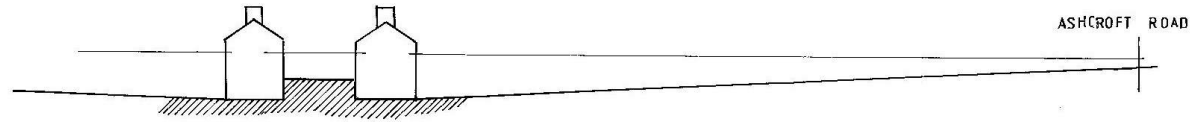

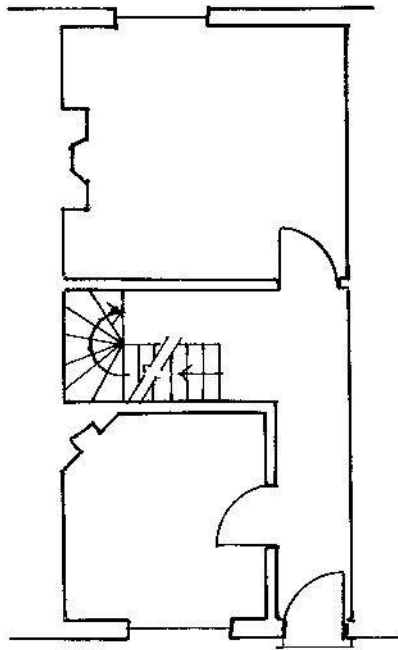

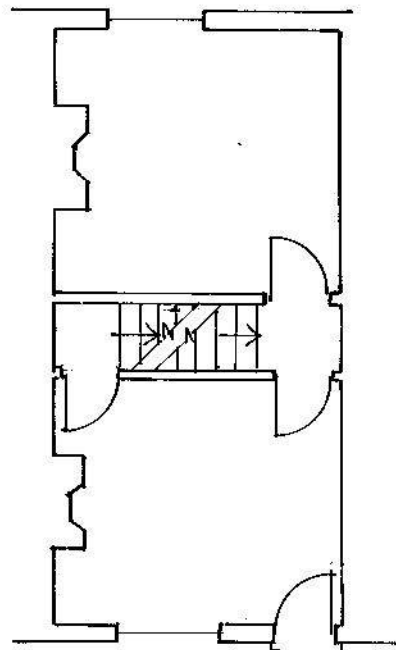
Topography of York Place



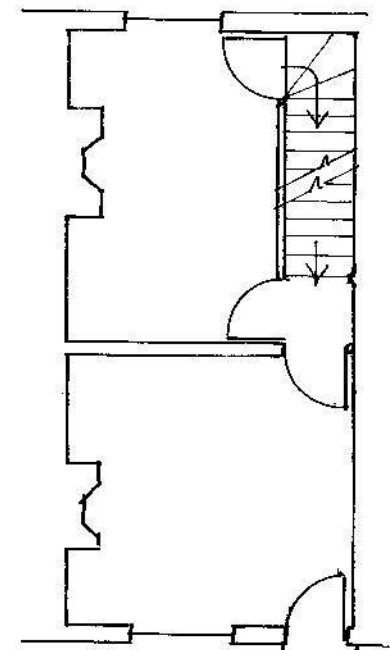
Plan Form of Houses

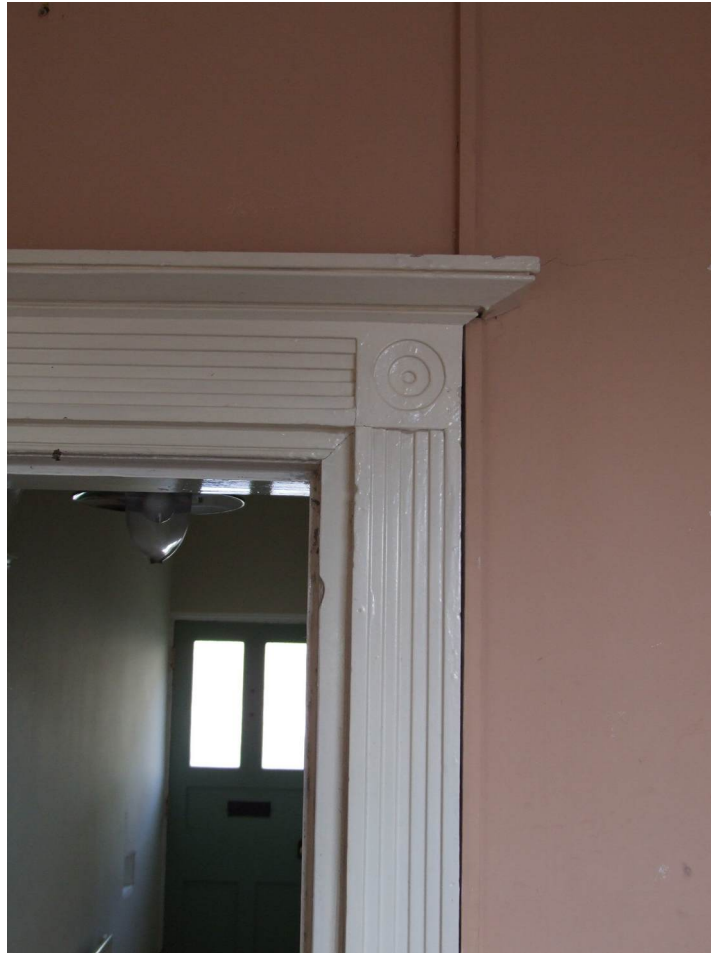
